Monday, January 30: *Faith. Academics. Service...in our Community*

- **Dress Like a Shining Star** (A positive role model) - This should be a real person either living or deceased. It can be a relative, someone in the community, or a famous person that exemplifies faith, service, and other positive traits. Please remember grades 5-6-7-8-1-2 have physical education.
